This special Working Hour during OpCo will feature a demonstration of creating a Work and an Instance description in Sinopia using PCC templates, followed by an open editing session during which participants will be encouraged to create their own descriptions in Sinopia.

Prior to the working hour, please <u>sign up for a Sinopia account</u>. Participants should bring a basic print monograph to work on during the session—for beginners, ideally a non-aggregate monograph that is not a translation. If you are not able to have an item-in-hand during the session, you could use an electronic version as a stand-in for the print from a source like <u>Open Library</u> or <u>Internet Archive</u>. If monographs are not your wheelhouse, it is also possible to work on several other formats in Sinopia using PCC templates.

Advance registration for the working hour is required; the number of registrants will be capped at 300 people.
