PETITION TO PARTICIPATE

Pursuant to Section 804 (b)(4) of the Copyright Act, Title 17, Section 351.1 (b) of the Copyright Royalty Judges Rules and Procedures, (37 CFR 351.1 (b)), and the Notice published in the Federal Register , Vol. 76, No. 3, Wednesday, January 5, 2011 , the Digital Media Association (“DiMA”), files this Petition stating its intention to participate in the above-captioned proceeding before the Copyright Royalty Judges to determine the reasonable rates and terms for making and distributing phonorecords (17 U.S.C.115) for the period beginning January 1, 2013, and ending on December 31, 2017.
