CHAP. 230.—An Act To reimburse certain Indians for labor done in building a schoolhouse at Queets River, Quinault Indian Reservation, in the State of Washington.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,* That the Secretary of the Interior, under such rules and regulations as he may prescribe, is hereby authorized to expend, in his discretion, not to exceed \$1,800, which sum is hereby appropriated, out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for payment to those Indians who present to him satisfactory evidence in support of their several claims for work performed during the year nineteen hundred and twelve in building a schoolhouse at Queets River, Quinault Indian Reservation, in the State of Washington: *Provided*, That said sum shall be reimbursed out of any funds in the Treasury now or hereafter placed to the credit of said Indians.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,* That the consent of Congress is hereby granted to Ashley County, Arkansas, and its successors and assigns, to construct, maintain, and operate a bridge and approaches thereto across the Bayou Bartholomew at a point suitable to the interests of navigation, at or near the town of Wilmot, in the county of Ashley, in the State of Arkansas, in accordance with the provisions of the Act entitled "An Act to regulate the construction of bridges over navigable waters," approved March twenty-third, nineteen hundred and six.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,* That the consent of Congress is hereby granted to Ashley County, Arkansas, and its successors and assigns, to construct, maintain, and operate a bridge and approaches thereto across Bayou Bartholomew at a point suitable to the interests of navigation, at or near Wilmot, Arkansas, on section line between sections one and twelve, township nineteen, range five, where it crosses said bayou in the county of Ashley in the State of Arkansas, in accordance with the provisions of the Act entitled "An Act to regulate the construction of bridges over navigable waters," approved March twenty-third, nineteen hundred and six.
