

THE Hero of this Print is the gentle Mr. Stamper, who is carrying to the Family Yault his favourite Child, in a Coffin, Mife Ams—range, about 12 Months old.

Anti-Sejamu, who reads the Burial Service, is the first in the Procession.—After him follow Two Pillars of the Law, supporting Two Black Elags: on which are the usual Stamper, consisting of the White Rose united with the Tripite, supposed to have been originally contrived on the Tenth of June. The expressive Motto of Semper caden is preserved: but the Price of the Stamp is changed to Three Farthings, which the
