	 The publisher supplies such volumes at the same time or There is explicit evidence that one or more of the volumes is continuously revised (typical of some legal publications) or The specific case clearly warrants such treatment.
	In such cases, always record the first or earliest edition statement in MARC field 250, and record information about other edition statements in a note (see Entities > Manifestation > note on edition statement).

Guidance	Statement of Responsibility Relating to Edition
	British Library practice: Take a statement of responsibility relating to edition from the same source as the designation of the edition.
	If two or more names are given, record all as indicated by the sequence, layout, or typography of the source of information.
	In case of doubt about whether a statement of responsibility applies to all editions or only to some, or if there is no designation of edition, or if it is the first edition, record such a statement as a statement of responsibility relating to title proper.

	If, in a revised edition, the responsibility belongs to the same author or collaborators as the first edition, the responsibility statement is recorded in relation to the title proper.

Guidance	When a new author/contributor is involved in a new edition, use cataloguer's judgement to determine whether they are contributing (by revising or clarifying content) to a new expression (so their statement of responsibility drops down to the edition statement) or if they are collaborating on a new work (in which case their statement of responsibility should relate to the title proper).
