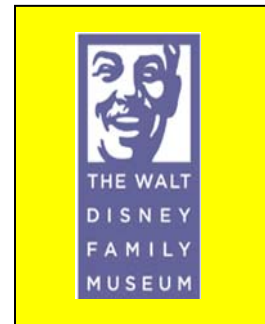

Comments:

- There is only one name to use as the basis of the preferred name
- Note the 370 Associated Place attribute (an "American" museum)
- The 371 Address attribute gives the museum's street address and web site address, and the justification on the museum's web site itself

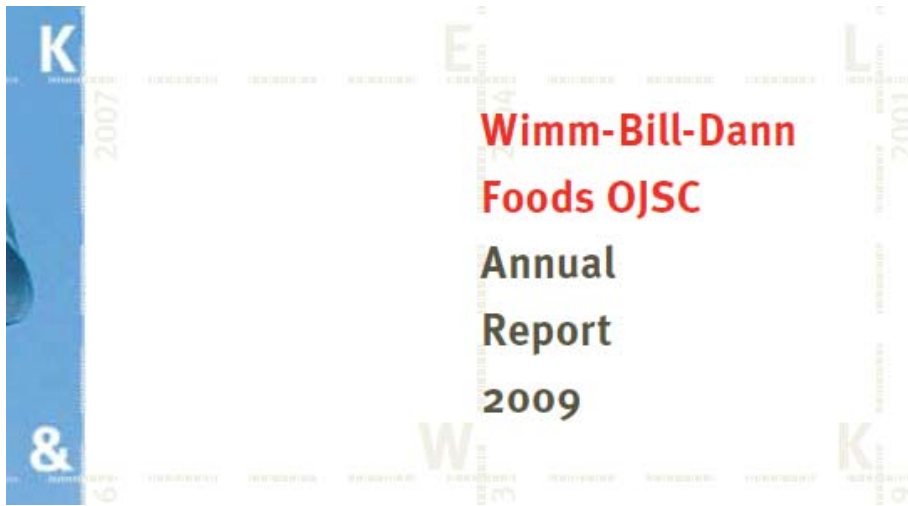

Comments:

- You might possibly consider the Russian-language form as the preferred name, but English is one of the languages of this corporate body, so no provisional coding is needed (RDA 11.2.2.5.2)
- OJSC = **Open Joint Stock Company** and might be omitted from the 1XX according to RDA 11.2.2.10, but included in 1XX here to "make it clear that the name is that of a corporate body."

Comments:

- In this case, Inc. is included in the preferred name since Virtual Ability on its own might not suggest “corporateness” (RDA 11.2.2.10)
- An Administrative History field 678 was added to describe the work of this body. This is cataloger’s judgment—the same information could have been incorporated into the 3xx area of the authority record, either instead of, or in addition to, the 678 field. I chose the 678 field because it was hard to parcel out the information into meaningful 3xx fields.

The **International Society for Theoretical Psychology** (ISTP) is an international forum for theoretical, meta-theoretical and philosophical discussions in **psychology**, with a focus on contemporary psychological debates. **Founded in the early 1980s**, its objective is to stimulate theoretical arguments and innovations, to foster integration across areas and traditions of research, and to promote interdisciplinary and transdisciplinary approaches to psychological questions. It aims to serve as the stage for the discussion of new theoretical ideas and

conceptual frameworks, for the critical engagement of different theoretical approaches, and for discussions concerning the relation of theoretical psychology to other disciplines, to the history of psychology and to the philosophy of knowledge. Conferences are held biennially, and since its first, founding conference in Plymouth (England), ISTP conferences have been in Banff (Canada), Arnhem (The Netherlands), Worcester (USA), Paris (France), Ottawa (Canada), Berlin (Germany), Calgary (Canada), Sydney (Australia), Istanbul (Turkey), Cape Town (South Africa), Toronto (Canada), Nanjing (China), with the next conference being in Thessaloniki (Greece) in 2011.

Comments:

- There is very little information in this resource to assist in the construction of the authorized access point. There is an indication that this is an ongoing conference, and for some of the other meetings, much more information is available (e.g., 15th Biennial ISTP Conference, meeting in Santiago, Chile, May 3-7, 2013), but this resource is on the 1999 conference, and no meeting location or number is given. So you go with what you have.
- The preferred name needs to be subordinate (RDA 11.2.2.14 TYPE 6)
- You need to also establish an authorized access point for the International Society for Theoretical Psychology, if one does not already exist
